At Kenosha Community Health Center (KCHC), our mission has always been to provide accessible, high-quality care for the communities we serve. In conjunction with our 30th anniversary, we're proud to announce the next step in that commitment: all KCHC clinic locations are transitioning to the Pillar Health brand.

This change reflects more than just a new name—it symbolizes our evolution into a fully integrated model of care that places patients and families at the center of everything we do. Since opening the first Pillar Health location at 4006 Washington Road in Kenosha in 2022, we've seen firsthand how a unified, team-based approach to medical, dental, and behavioral health services can transform outcomes and improve lives.

For decades, we have been a longstanding pillar of strength in Southeast Wisconsin, with deep roots in the community. Our original logo of a tree reflected this history, with a strong base and many branches symbolizing the roots and connections we've built and the growth we've nurtured. Our new, more modern image embraces our holistic approach to care and better reflects our evolving services and unwavering commitment to being a true pillar of support for our community.

By transitioning all clinics to Pillar Health, we are:

- Expanding access to integrated, whole-person care across Southeast Wisconsin.
- Enhancing services with a health home model that connects patients to a team of professionals dedicated to their physical, mental, and emotional well-being.
- Building a stronger foundation of care using evidence-based approaches, personalized treatment plans, and local resources to meet each patient's unique needs.
- Expanding portable, school-based oral health prevention services through the Wisconsin Seal-A-Smile Program, growing from 16 to 36 schools, with continued growth.
- Sustaining growth of mental health services recently expanded by 3.5 FTE psychiatry positions, boosting annual visits from 2,864 to 10,464.
- Providing cardiology services to address high referral needs.

While our name is changing, our mission remains the same: to provide compassionate, comprehensive care that helps every individual and family thrive.

We are proud to grow as Pillar Health—a trusted, enduring pillar of support in the communities we serve.

Our commitment goes beyond clinical visits—we focus on breaking down barriers to care and supporting the whole person.

HERE'S A LOOK AT WHO WE SERVE AND HOW WE HELP:



ENABLING SERVICES:

In 2024, we provided **2,001 enabling services visits**, helping patients with case management, financial counseling, care coordination, and more—ensuring they can navigate the complex healthcare system with confidence.



SLIDING FEE DISCOUNTS:

In fiscal year 2025, we provided **\$2.2 million** in discounts through our Sliding Fee Discount Program, reducing the financial burden for families in need and ensuring no one has to forgo care due to cost.



WHERE OUR PATIENTS LIVE:

Our patients come from all across Kenosha, Racine, and Walworth Counties, including urban and many rural areas west of I-94. This wide reach ensures care is **accessible to both urban and rural communities**.



LANGUAGE ACCESS:

We proudly serve a diverse patient population, with over **3,200 individuals** best served in a language other than English—primarily Spanish-speaking families—ensuring language is never a barrier to quality care.



FINANCIAL NEED:

A significant portion of our community faces economic challenges. More than **5,000** of our patients have household incomes **below 200% of the federal poverty level**, underscoring the importance of affordable, accessible care.



INSURANCE ENROLLMENT ASSISTANCE:

Navigating insurance can be overwhelming. That's why we helped nearly **1,000 families** enroll in health insurance this past year—connecting them to critical coverage and peace of mind.

Pillar Health and Kenosha Community Health Center are more than clinics—we are pillars of support, working every day to improve health equity and create a healthier, stronger Southeast Wisconsin.

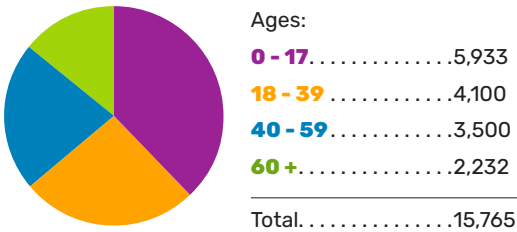

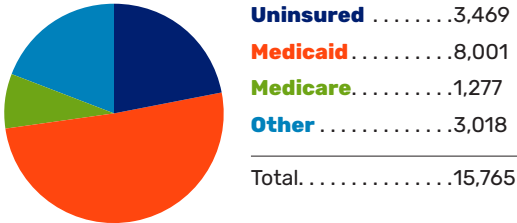
PATIENTS BY AGE:

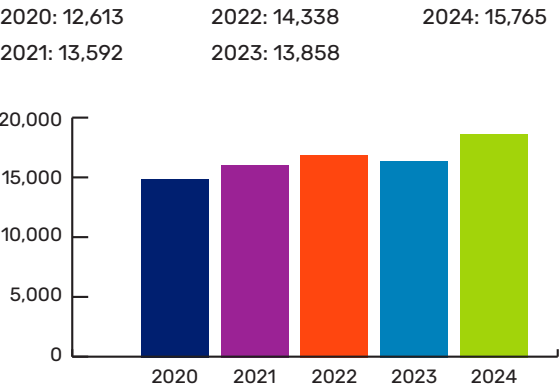
